HELOC VS. HOME EQUITY LOAN

HELOCs and Home Equity Loans are often mistaken for being the same thing. They are not. While they both use your home's equity, there are some key differences.

- A home equity loan is a lump sum, one-time equity draw. Home equity loans have fixed rates and payments.
- A home equity line of credit (HELOC), on the other hand, is a line of credit that can be used in multiple transactions over a set period of time. HELOCs have variable rates so the payments may fluctuate, depending on rates and the amount borrowed.

A HELOC or home equity loan can be a convenient, flexible, and low-cost way to borrow money for expenses such as home improvements, medical bills, children's college expenses, and debt consolidation.
